EXIT COUNSELING FOR STUDENT BORROWERS

Exit Counseling Session

Federal regulations require that anyone who has borrowed a Federal Stafford Loan at Pennsylvania Institute of Technology complete an Exit Counseling Session. The purpose of this session is to inform all federal student loan borrowers of their loan repayment rights and responsibilities. This is required anytime that your enrollment is less than half-time, you graduate or withdraw from the College.

Loan Repayment

Repayment begins six months after a student graduates, drops below half-time or stops attending school.
